SPECTATOR/PARENT - Code of Behaviour

COACH - Code of Behaviour

- Positively reinforce the actions of players.
- Lead by example.
- Be honest with yourself and players.
- Create an enjoyable environment in which to play the game.
- Develop team respect for referees.
- Give all players the opportunity to participate.
- Insist on fair play and discipline.
- Be reasonable on the demands on players time, energy and enthusiasm.
- Encourage sportsmanship.
